What are the SENIOR LIVING OPTIONS?

Seniors offer many different levels of care. When it comes to yourself or your loved one, think about physical and medical needs, but also social needs, as well as financial concerns.

Independent Living

Seniors are for those who need much less assistance than those who need a lot of help. They are for those who want to live in a safe place for themselves and their families, but who still want to live independently. They are for those who want to live in a safe place for themselves and their families, but who still want to live independently.

Assisted Living

Assisted living facilities provide a little bit of assistance. These are places where people who need help with daily activities, including medication management, bathing, grooming and eating can get the assistance they need while still maintaining some level of independence.

Alzheimer's Care

Alzheimer's Care, also known as memory care, is a safe place for those suffering from dementia and memory loss. These facilities have strong security to ensure the safety of their residents, and activities are provided by specially trained staff members familiar with the concerns of residents with this diagnosis.

Skilled Nursing Center

Skilled nursing centers offer the highest level of care available, outside of a hospital. With round the clock medical staff, they are a good choice for people who have medical needs too great to handle at home or in another facility.

What are the DIFFERENT SENIOR LIVING OPTIONS?

Home Care

Home care providers allow a senior to live at home. This may be a good option, provided that the senior has a strong support network. Home care agencies can provide companion care and assistance with the bathing, grooming, transportation, shopping and more. Additionally, there are medical home care agencies that can provide medical care.

Adult Day Care

Adult day care and respite care offer temporary solutions. These types of facilities offer a "break" to family members who are caring for an elderly loved one. Adult day care, just as it sounds, provides daily assistance, while respite care can accommodate seniors for a week, or even a month.

CCRC

One option that many people find to be a good solution is a multi-level care facility, also called a Life Care Community, a Continuing Care Retirement Community, or CCRC. These communities typically offer independent and assisted living, as well as medical and skilled nursing care if and when needed. The wider range of care is helpful so that once a senior moves into the community, they are able to age in place knowing that their needs will be taken care of. CCRCs are usually a purchase type alternative requiring upfront costs. By choosing this type of situation, you will be providing a safety net, in case your circumstance changes.

Taking the First Steps to Researching YOUR ALTERNATIVES

There are many different options available for today's seniors. Sometimes, seniors and family members opt to take care of themselves with a strong family network; however, often in today's day and age that is not feasible. More and more women, historically the family caregivers, are in the work force, have young children at home, or as seen more and more, families move across the country resulting in trying to assist with family decisions from a distance. When you think you need to seek care outside of the family, there are a few things to consider.

- First, learn as much as you can about different types of senior communities.** One great option is a community offering both independent living and assisted living, and nursing care, depending on which one is right for you or a loved one. Remember, situations always change, and someone who is perfectly served in an independent living facility today may need assistance with the activities of daily living (bathing, eating, grooming, dressing) and even medical assistance in the near future.
- Next, assess your condition.** Sometimes, a person may be unwilling to give up independence, but if you are concerned for your well-being or a family member's safety, emotional well-being, or health, it is time to be honest about things and formulate a plan. You might decide that hiring a companion is sufficient, or that an independent living community may fit the bill. Whatever needs to be done, discuss the options and find the solution that is best for your family.
- Then, consider the financial ramifications.** The costs involved with the different alternatives can vary significantly, so it is wise to gather as much information as you can before making any decisions. Will you own or rent living space? Would it be more practical to move or to hire in-home assistance? Can Medicare or health insurance help with the costs? Keep in mind that Medicare and other governmental assistance does not generally pay for senior living other than nursing home care. Being well informed will give you the confidence to make the best decision.

While it can be a challenge to determine what is best, it doesn't have to be overwhelming. Begin thinking about your options before the situation becomes dire, and you will be able to make a plan that will serve you well when you need it.


